NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT at their regular meeting held March 2, 2021, the City Council of the City of National City introduced a proposed ordinance for first reading, which if adop-ted, would add Chapter 9.60 of the National City Municipal Code concerning regulation of com-mercial cannabis activity, otherwise known as the Commercial Cannabis Ordinance.

The proposed ordinance would add Chapter 9.60 to the National City Municipal Code concerning regulation of commercial cannabis activity and the cultivation, processing, manufacturing testing, sale, delivery, distribution and transportation of cannabis and cannabis products in a responsible manner to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of National City and to enforce rules and regulations consistent with state and local law.

The provisions of this proposed ordinance will be in addition to any other permits, licenses and approvals which may be required to conduct business in the City of National City, and are in addition to any permits, licenses and approval re-quired under state, City, or other law. The City Council of the City of National City will
